We are deeply distressed by the current situation in which many Ukrainian citizens are in danger of losing their lives for a long period of time due to the invasion of Ukraine by Russia.

Sagamihara City has accepted evacuees from Ukraine as its citizens and has been providing various kinds of support for their daily lives in cooperation with private companies in the city.

Furthermore, in order to support people in Ukraine, including victims of the war and those who have been forced to evacuate, the city has established the "Ukraine Humanitarian Assistance Donation" and accepted donations from March 24 to May 31, 2022 from people within and outside the city.

A total of 138 people donated 3,809,062 yen. We would like to donate it to your embassy to be used for humanitarian assistance to the people of Ukraine.

In 1984, Sagamihara declared itself as a "Peaceful City for the Abolition of Nuclear Weapons" and has been working toward the realization of a world without nuclear weapons and lasting peace in the world. We sincerely hope that peace and smiles will return to the people of Ukraine, and we promise to remain close to the people of your country and continue to support them at all times.
